Terms of Reference

1. To meet at least twice per year.
2. To review the operation and development of the BSc (Hons) in Medical Science Programme
3. To receive and approve appropriate schemes for learning and teaching activities from participating departments to achieve the learning outcomes defined for the degree and to forward these to the HYMS intercalated Honours BSc (Hons) in Medical Science Programme (Hull and York) Board of Examiners for approval before the scheme is made available to prospective students.
4. To report and to submit minutes to the HYMS Board of Studies (for academic issues) and the HYMS Executive (for management issues).
5. Where necessary to arrange interviews for the selection of candidates for the programme to determine a ranking of candidates and recommend it to the HYMS Board of Studies for decisions on admission.
6. To consider such other relevant businesses as may be deemed appropriate by the HYMS Board of Studies.
