

# HULL YORK MEDICAL SCHOOL

## CAMPUS ALLOCATION - MBBS

1. All applicants who have firmly accepted a place at HYMS will be allocated (usually by ballot) to either Hull or York for their first two years, in order to create two balanced classes.
2. Anyone accepting a place must be equally prepared to be allocated to either campus.
3. Campus allocation requests (under point 6) should not be submitted and will not be considered until an applicant has firmly accepted their place at HYMS.
4. Thus applicants who accept HYMS as their insurance offer will not be allocated until that has been changed to firm acceptance, usually in late August.
5. All HYMS students in years 3, 4 and 5 must be prepared to undertake placements across the whole HYMS region including Hull, York, Scarborough, Scunthorpe and Grimsby.
6. The only exceptions to the year 1 + 2 random allocation process are:
  - 6.1 Applicants who intend to live at home during term time, provided their home is within a specified distance of the campus (normally 30 miles), can apply to be allocated to the campus nearest to their home. Approval by the HYMS Board of Studies is required for students to live 31 to 45 miles away, and by the University Special Cases Committee to live further than this.

*Applicants must understand that they may have to leave the course if they cannot meet the required standards of attendance and performance because of the demands of daily travelling or domestic commitments.*
  - 6.2 Applicants resident at the time of their UCAS application in the HYMS catchment area (ie whose Local Education Authority is either Humber, N Lincs, NE Lincs, York, Hull, N Yorks or East Riding) may request either to be allocated to the campus nearest their home or to be entered in to the ballot for allocation to either Hull or York.
  - 6.3 Applicants registered at the time of their UCAS application at either the University of York or the University of Hull may request either to be allocated to the campus in which they are currently studying or to be entered in to the ballot for allocation to either Hull or York.
  - 6.4 Applicants who have a sibling registered at either the University of York or the University of Hull who is not in the final year of study may request either to be allocated to the campus in which their sibling is registered or request to be allocated to the other campus.

Applicants in any of these categories must firmly accept the offer of a place at HYMS and then submit a written request by the end of April to HYMS Admissions Officer. The applicant will be informed of the outcome in June.
